**Functions and Duties of the Anti Ragging Squad**

1. To be vigilant at all hours including at odd hours all around the Campus and to inspect other places vulnerable to incidents of and having the potential of ragging.
2. To conduct anonymous random surveys among freshers to check whether the Campus is indeed free from ragging.
3. To ensure the display of posters on Main and Departmental Notice Boards and other places such as canteen, Library, Sports Lounge, Gymnasium and other prominent designated places.

4. To monitor the welfare of fresh students outside the campus
5. To conduct an on-the-spot enquiry into any incident of ragging referred to it by the Head of the institution or any member of the faculty or any member of the staff or any student or any parent or guardian or any employee of a service provider or by any other person, as the case may be; and the enquiry report along with recommendations shall be submitted to the Anti-Ragging Committee.
