NOTICE INVITING QUOTATION

Sealed Quotations are invited by the Director, CERI, Karaikudi for collecting the yields of the following fruit bearing trees in the CECRI's waste land area:

1. Cashew nut trees(yielding) – 900 Nos.
2. Mango trees - 80 Nos.
3. Jack fruit trees - 60 Nos.
4. Sappota trees - 50 Nos.

Quotation should be submitted in a sealed cover along with EMD of Rs.1000/- in the form of D.D. favouring Director, CECRI on or before 26.03.2007 by 3.00 p.m. and the quotations will be opened at 3.30 p.m. same day in the presence of tenderers.

Terms & Conditions

1. The intender could visit the area from 14.03.2007 to 23.03.2007 and inspect the trees between 9.00 a.m and 5.00 p.m with prior permission of the in-charge (Horticulture).
2. The quoted amount should not be less than the one fixed by the CECRI authorities for each item, which will be made known on the day of the auction.
3. The highest quoted shall be awarded permission to collect the produce from the trees.
4. The Quotations may be sent along with EMD amount of Rs.1000/-in the form of DD in favouring Director, CECRI, karaikudi.
5. The highest quoted should deposit on-the-spot 50% of the quoted amount with the Cashier, CECRI and the rest 50% within a week's time from the date of receipt of the award letter from CECRI.
6. In case of failure on the part of the highest quoted to make on –the –spot payment, the next highest quoted shall become eligible for award of the quote.

7. The duration for collection of produce of the trees is upto 30-06-2007 from the date of the award of the auction.
8. The awardee of the auction is responsible for any cause of damage to the trees during the course of collection and adequate compensation as shall be fixed by the Director, CECRI for such damage if any, caused shall be payable by the awardee.
9. The awardee shall make his own arrangements for collection and transportation of the produce. CECRI will not be responsible for any injury caused to the labourers engaged by the awardee while collecting the produce from the trees. He should arrange insurance cover to the labourers engaged by him.
10. The awardee should obtain material pass out from the Security Section before the items are taken out.
11. Director, CECRI reserves the right to reject all or accept any of the without assigning any reason whatsoever, and in case of disputes, if any, pertaining to this the decision of the Director, CECRI shall be final and binding.
